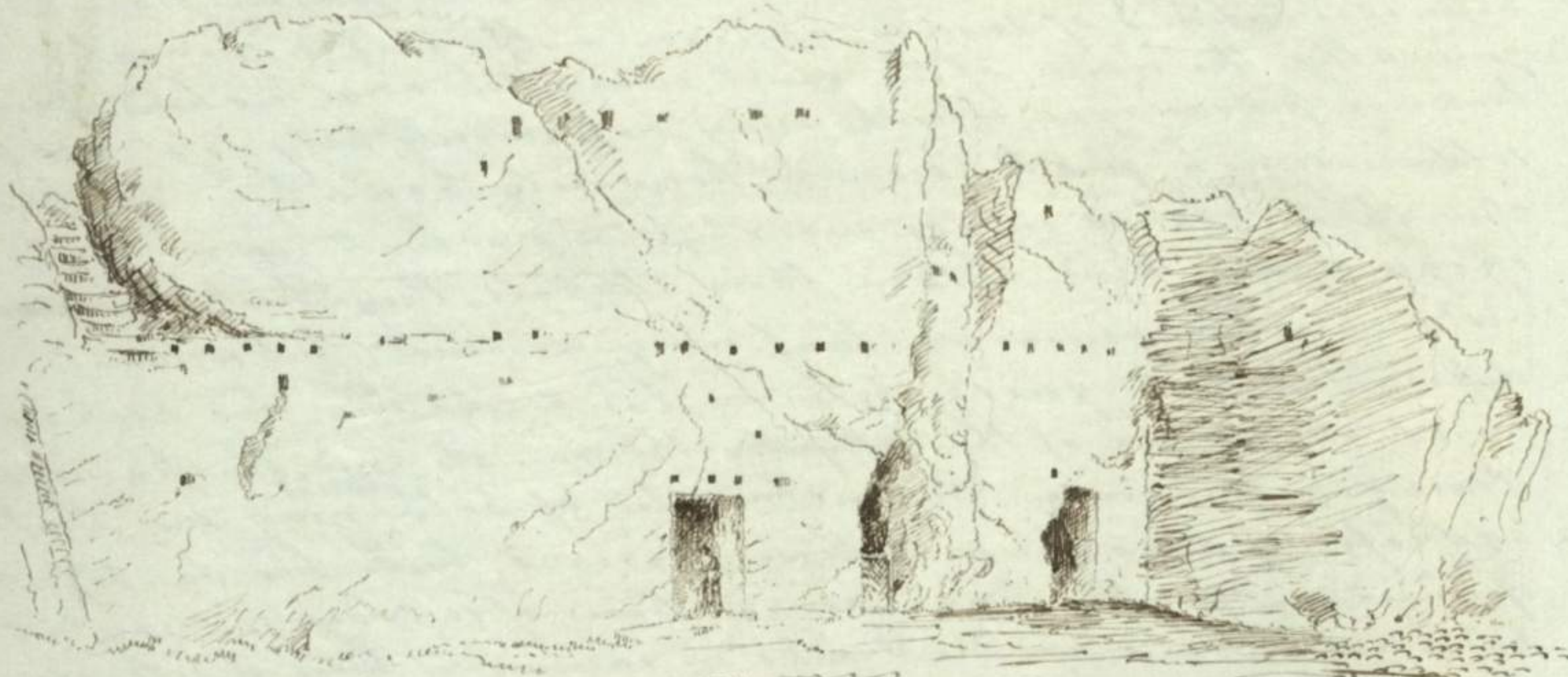


* This was the Bema "a word which seems synonymous with
